

RIDING THE OZARK MOUNTAINS

Pig Trail Scenic Byway

The 19-mile-long Pig Trail Scenic Byway runs along Arkansas 23 through the Boston Mountains, from the southern boundary of the Ozark National Forest, 10 miles North of the town of Ozark, to Arkansas 16 in Brashear's



Come join our chapter members as they once again set out on another adventure to explore this great country. Two of the best rides are THE PIG TRAIL and SCENIC ROUTE 7. You will travel through the BOSTON MOUNTAINS, OUACHITA MOUNTAINS and THE OZARK MOUNTAINS. The trip up to CLARKSVILLE will be mostly on Interstates as the route to the Ozarks is just over 1035 miles and will take about two and a half days. Whether you trailer or ride we will make it fun for all, rain or shine as we have in the past. This is a great opportunity to get to know new and old friends from this great chapter of ours. These rides are organized and led by our Road Captains so all H.O.G. rules apply, all two and a half of them.

Our route will be on a lot of Interstate and Major roads to get to Clarksville where we will be staying in a Quality Inn or Best Western hotel with a hot breakfast daily. The "PIG TRAIL" is a ride not to miss along with "ROUTE 7 SCENIC" which we might split up into two days because of the long distance. There are a few shorter rides such as "THE TWISTED LADY", "ARKANSAS GRAND CANYON", "JASPER DISASTER", "OZARK MOONSHINE RUN" and "PEEL FERRY ROUTE" that we can do.

During the time frame that we are there Fayetteville Arkansas might be having their HOG Rally. If it is convenient, we might be able to attend if the group would like to do it.

On the way up we will be spending one night just prior to Mobile Alabama and the second around Pine Bluff Arkansas. These two overnight stays will be set up for you to make your reservations. The third day of travel will take the morning and will leave us the afternoon to start some short rides. We will spend the next five days doing the rides in the mountains of The Arkansas Ozarks. The ride home will be on your own and no rooms or routes are set up for the return. I suggest you go back in small groups for safety.

The phone numbers of hotels will be posted as soon as I can get conformations and prices. When you make your reservations ask if you qualify for additional discounts such as military, AAA or others you may have.
